Details:

On Oct. 4, 2018, Burke Deputies were called to the scene of 200 Main Ave. West, Hildebran where Travis Michael Coble was inside the residence. Warrants for arrest for five counts of B&E and five counts of Second-Degree Trespass had been issued on Oct. 3rd, for Coble illegally entering that residence. Subsequent to Coble refusing to come to the door, Deputies assisted by K9 “Zane” made entry into residence. After multiple warnings, K9 Zane was deployed and indicated on a cabinet in the basement. The K9 handler deputy pulled the cabinet door open and Coble violently exited cursing and swinging at the deputy and kicking the K9 in a confined area. K9 Zane bit Coble and Coble was pushed over a recliner chair. The K9 jumped over the recliner and reengaged Coble until deputies could restrain and cuff Coble.

Coble was transported to the hospital by EMS where he was treated and medically released. He was subsequently taken to the magistrate where he was served with the five outstanding warrants and in addition, was charged for two counts of Assault on a Government Official (the K9 and he K9 handler) and Resisting a Public Officer.

Coble was transported to Burke-Catawba District Confinement Facility where he was held under a \$45,000 secured bond with a court date for October 10, 2018.
